**Port of Friday Harbor** is seeking a qualified contractor to perform an expansion of the existing Mullis Stormwater Detention Pond at the Friday Harbor Airport. This project includes excavation and embankment construction for an approximate one-acre expansion to the existing pond, modifications to the existing flow control structure, chain-link fence installation, and restoration and revegetation of disturbed areas.

Sealed Bids shall be addressed to **the Port of Friday Harbor, 204 Front Street, PO Box 889, Friday Harbor, Washington, 98250, Attention: Phyllis Johnson**, and will be received until **3:00 p.m.**, local time, on **July 23, 2019**, and then will be publicly opened and read. Bids submitted after the above-specified time shall not be received or opened.

The Bidder must agree that the requirements and conditions of employment be observed and minimum wage rates, as established by the U.S. Secretary of Labor, or the Washington State Department of Labor and Industries, whichever is higher, be paid under the Contract.

No bid for a construction contract shall be received or considered by Port of Friday Harbor unless the Bidder is registered with the Washington State Department of Licenses, as required by RCW 18.27
