This MOU involves the purchase of property rights along the shoreline of parcels 351341002, 351341003, & 351341004 (see MOU sketch) in exchange for engineering and permitting along with \$100,000.00 towards the construction of a bulkhead on parcel 351341003. The compensation for these property rights has been calculated to be equivalent to the cost reductions associated with the enabled Port Management Area expansion.

*Recommended action*: Motion to approve Port Director's signature on Ahrenius Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and additional documents necessary to execute the terms of the MOU.

C. RESOLUTION #19-012 Port Management Area Amendment

This Resolution allows for the amendment of the Port Management Area (PMA) expanding the PMA to the East and West of Jensen's Boatyard and Marina to include the area in front of Shipyard Cove and parcels 351341002, 351341003, & 351341004.

D. Mullis Pond Contract Change Order (CO)

An error in the engineering calculations for excavated quantities, along with a change in bank stabilization materials and methods resulted in an additional cost of \$123,612.57 plus tax. The FAA has approved the CO and is covering 90% of the cost.
