Principle Purpose of Job: Fabricators are manufactures of assorted products using various raw materials, tools, and their own hands.

Level Of Authority: Receives moderate supervision, depending on experience and complexity of task. Employee is expected to perform routine assignments independently following the established schedule and standard practice.

Work Environment: Work is performed both indoors and outdoors in all weather conditions, hot, cold, wind, rain, snow, etc. Work will sometimes take place in marine environments. Most work environments will require the proper PPE.

Essential Job Functions: Safely and efficiently using a wide range of both hand and power tools. Cutting and welding various materials. Reading and understanding blueprints and construction plans. Listening to, and understanding verbal direction. Contributing ideas to better our products, production process, working conditions, public image, ect. Driving Port vehicles, including cars, trucks, boats, and electric vehicles in all weather conditions. Operating heavy equipment, such as but not limited to, forklift, manlift, boom truck, crane, telehandler, marine travel lift, excavator, skid-steer, tracktors, mowers, etc. Ability to do basic math, read various measuring tools, and retain information. Ability to lift and move heavy objects safely, sometimes up to 70lbs. Willingness to learn new skills, be flexible, and share knowledge you have accrued in past experiences. Complete tasks efficiently alone, or as part of a team. Treating fellow employees, community, and the public with respect.

Additional Job Functions:

The essential functions should not be considered an all-inclusive listing of work requirements. Individuals may perform other duties as assigned, including work in other functional areas to cover absences or provide relief, to equalize peak work periods, or otherwise balance the workload and meet the emergency and ongoing needs of the Port and marina.

Qualifications:

1. A valid Washington state driver's license and be insurable.
2. Ability to obtain and maintain a FIRST AID/CPR card.
3. Ability to obtain and maintain certification on various equipment as needed.
4. Be a United States citizen or have the proper authorization to work in Washinton state.
5. Physical strength and ability to lift, bend, twist, kneel, climb, crawl, walk on uneven and varied surfaces.
6. At least 3 years of fabrication, production, or construction experience.
7. Ability to communicate with co-workers and the public.
8. Must be willing to comply with safety requirements, use of PPE and proper clothing.
9. Must be able to get to and from work reliably.
10. A positive attitude.
