Interlocal Cooperation Agreement

Parties to the agreement: San Juan Island School District

University of Washington Friday Harbor Labs (K-12)
Science Outreach Program (FHLSOP)

Friday Harbor Port District (Port of Friday Harbor)

The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate the gathering of information, which is important for the Friday Harbor Port District, the University of Washington Friday Harbor Labs Science Outreach Program and to provide valuable teaching and learning experience for the students of the San Juan Island School District. This agreement authorizes the Friday Harbor Port District to pay \$3,300 to the University of Washington to be used to conduct a water sampling and analysis program in the Friday Harbor Port District Marina. Progress reports and the final written results of the program will be submitted to the Port District.

WHEREAS:

- A. Each listed entity has an interest in this project to sample and measure water quality in the Friday Harbor Port District Marina.
 - B. The Friday Harbor Elementary School is offering a program to 5th grade classes to take water samples from specified locations in the Port of Friday Harbor Marina and test five parameters of water quality which are of interest to the Port District Commissioners and staff.
 - C. The sponsors of the program have asked the Port of Friday Harbor to pay for the costs of materials and equipment for conducting the tests in the Port District Marina which is determined to be \$3,300.00 and the Friday Harbor Port Commission determined that the value of the information provided to the Port exceeds the costs for the program.
 - D. The methodology for the collection and analysis of the samples along with the sampling locations are shown in "Attachment A" to this agreement.
 - E. Friday Harbor Port District staff will assist the managers of the program to obtain access to the marina and time and dates when sampling is desirable.
 - F. The Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 39.34 RCW, authorizes public agencies of the San Juan Island School District, the University of Washington Friday Harbor Laboratories, and the Friday Harbor Port District to enter into agreements for their mutual benefit.
- THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and mutual undertakings and obligations set forth below the parties hereto now covenant and agree as follows:

The Friday Harbor Port District will pay to the University of Washington in the amount not to exceed \$3,300.00 for the calendar year 1/1/2023 – 12/31/2023. This amount shall be used for materials and

equipment for a two-season water sampling and testing program conducted by 5th grade students under the supervision of the Friday Harbor Labs Science Outreach Program staff. It is the responsibility of the University of Washington to bill the Port of Friday Harbor.


The Port of Friday Harbor shall be provided progress reports and final written results of the sampling and testing program.
