A. 2024 Fireworks Budget Request

Becky Day with Friday Harbor Chamber of Commerce shared with the Commission the local sponsors for the annual Firework show. She noted that this year was the first year that she did not have to request additional funds due to avid fundraising and the Port's donation. The Chamber of Commerce is requesting a contribution from the Port of \$5,000 for the 2024 Firework show.

The Commission was supportive and will consider this when putting together the 2024 Budget.

Approval of Minutes: September 13, 2023, Meeting Minutes

Commissioner Black made a motion to approve the September 13, 2023, Meeting Minutes. Commissioner Marrett seconded, all in favor, meeting minutes approved unanimously.

Approval of Vouchers: Payroll and Vouchers 04156-04201 for \$429,947.38

Commissioner Black made a motion to approve the payroll and vouchers. Commissioner Marrett seconded, all in favor, all items approved unanimously.

Discussion Items:

A. Passenger Landing Fees vs AIP/PFC for Seaplanes

The Executive Director discussed with the Commission the possibility of implementing passenger fees for Seaplanes in the Marina. As it stands now, although Cruise Lines and Whale watching boats are charged passenger fees, Seaplanes are not. Revenue from passenger fees would help to cover capital investments.

B. Destination Management Plan Comments

The Executive Director and Commissioners discussed their views and opinions on the Destination Management Plan and came to the agreement that the Port is supportive of efforts to disperse the volume of visitors and promoting the shoulder season in order to alleviate pressure of Peak season travel. The Port also supports expansions of mooring buoys and hiking and biking trails to the extent that local government entities can afford. The Port is not supportive of any version of fees for bikes, cars, and boats to visit the area and feels as though capacity research would be a valuable planning tool.

C. Eric Ffitch, WPPA, Visit on October 19that 3:00 PM

Commissioner Marrett stated she would be in attendance. Commissioner Black agreed to attend via Zoom.

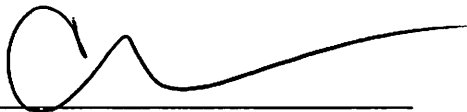
Port Commissioner and Committee Reports:
